Kujawsko-Pomorskie Region

- 3 milion tourists (85% local tourists, 15% foreign tourists)
- Foreign tourists: Germany (29,7%), UK (7,5%), France (5,1%), Italy (4,5%)
- 152 hotels in the region
- 1,3 milion tourists used the accommodation base
- 4,5 milion nights spent in tourist accommodation establishments






